- 5. To preserve and promote the <u>arts and culture</u>.













This is the foreword for my Comic Book "Da Stick Up" written back in 2002.

Hmm...t he past year or so seems like it could have either been the most productive or least productive year in my life. I don't know. On the one hand I finished a 250-plus page comic book with "total" creative control (that is, control limited only by my deficiencies as a writer and artist, and my unimaginable laziness (and really, I apologize for the inconsistent quality of the drawing)), and on the other hand I spent most of the year sitting at the same desk for months on end, cooped up in my house and letting it rot my body and brain. "I should have been working," one side of me says. I should have been out gaining "real world" experience like all my friends and peers. I should have been growing into a responsible adult. Instead, I seem to have devolved; wasting my college education (the business part of it anyway) in exchange for something you supposedly don't need to go to school for, for something kids can do. I don't know.

And yet, I know I'm incredibly lucky in another way. The comic book was given (basically) my full attention, without the myriad distractions other people might have to put up with if they were going to school or holding down a job while they were trying to do their big creative projects. Now, I had no excuses. So I did it. And here it is, the final product that I put more of myself and my thought into than anything I've ever done in my life so far. I now have something precious to me that I personally created with my bare hands.

Then again, I look at it, and I say "That's it?" 250 pages? And it's a comedy? This is what you toiled over? I'm under no delusions that there will be somebody out there who cares about this comic book more than me. To the rest of the world it's something to do to pass the time for about an hour or so. (If they even like it.) So, I don't know.









