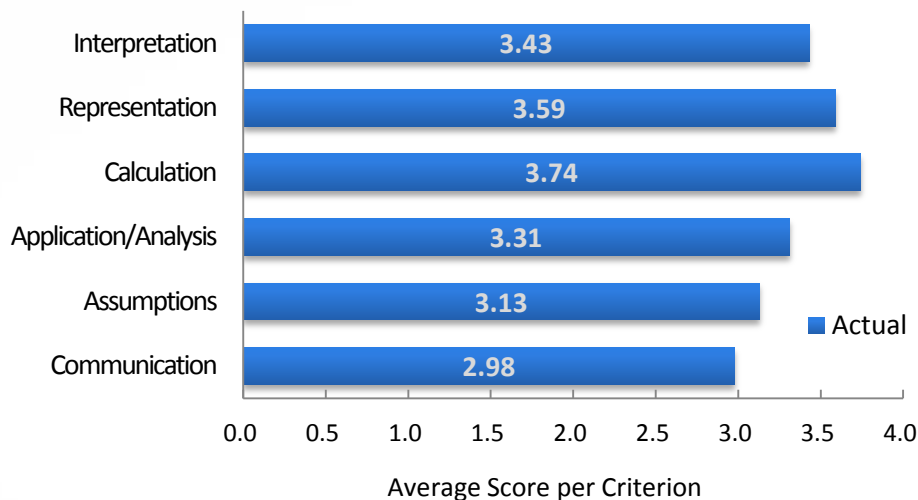

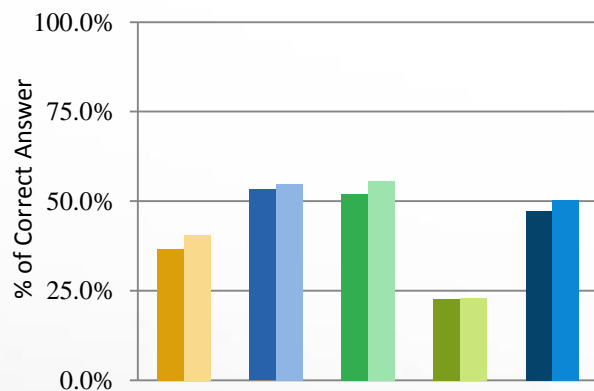

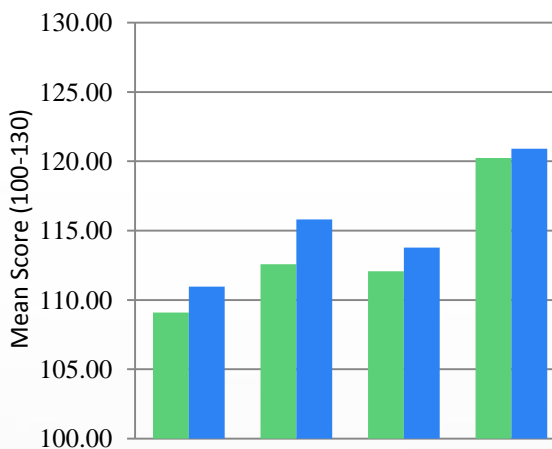
Focus Group Interviews Students' Perceived Achievement of Learning Outcomes

- Improve critical thinking.

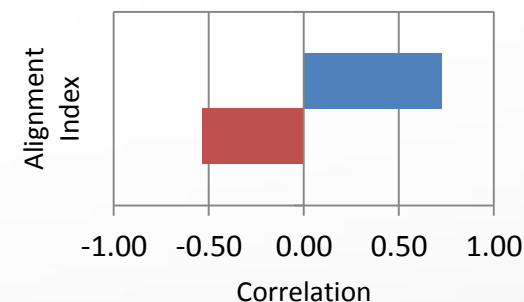

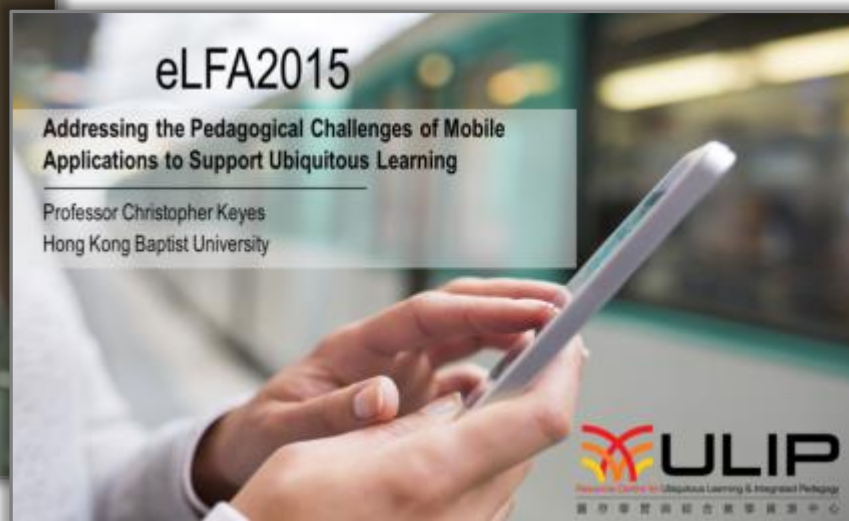
SUMMARY & COMMENT

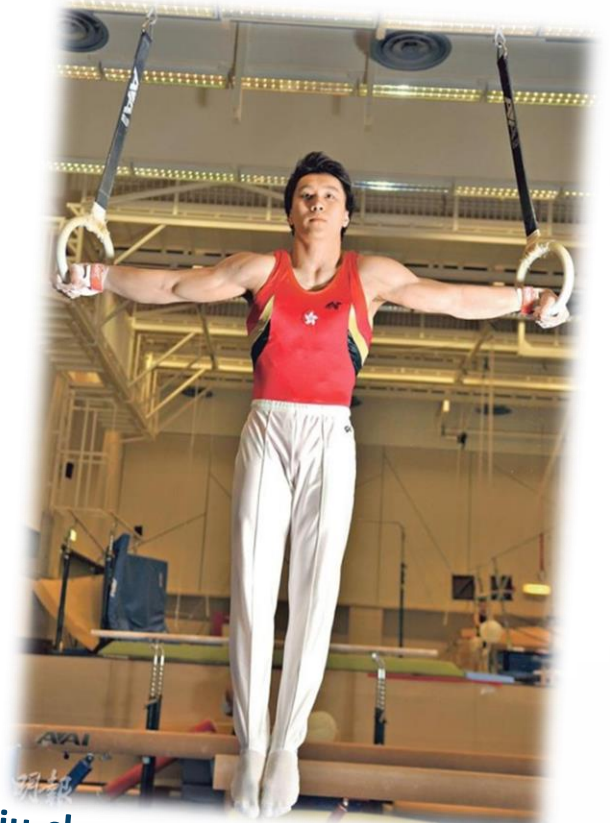

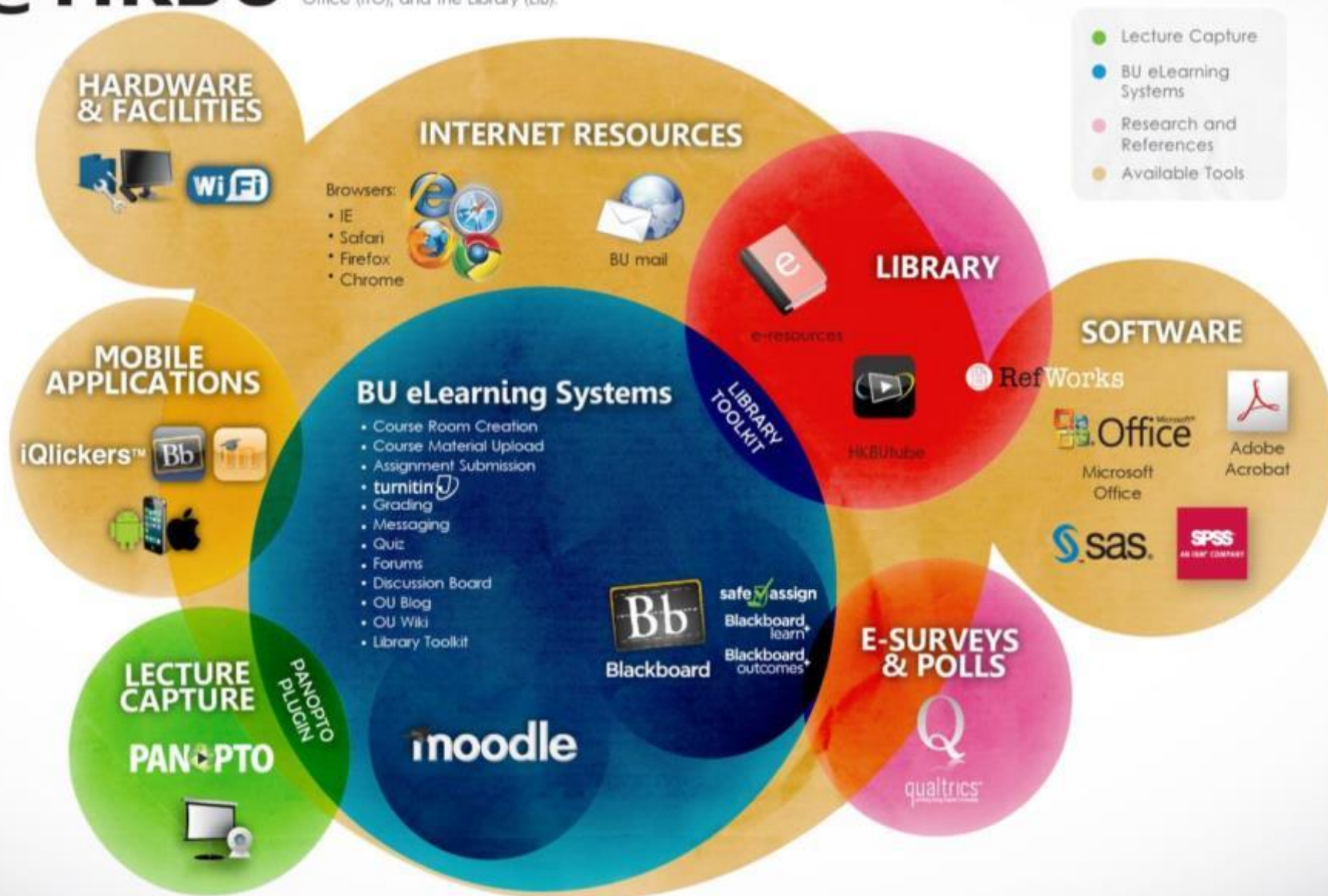
